

## ***News Release***

(14 January 2013, Fredericton, New Brunswick)-The New Brunswick Aboriginal Peoples Council is pleased to announce the approval of the Business Continuity Plan proposal. The Business Continuity Plan was approved for \$16,545.14 by the Métis and Non-Status Indian Relations, Aboriginal and External Relations Branch, Policy and Strategic Direction of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada.

The New Brunswick Aboriginal Peoples Council does not currently have a plan of action to implement in the event that any foreseeable issues arise, causing disruptions or halting program and service delivery. The purpose of the Business Continuity Plan is to have established a clear concise written set of procedures for each of the programs and services offered by NBAPC to prepare for unseen circumstances which could have a major impact on the daily operations of the organization.

NBAPC has hired a consultant to develop the Business Continuity Plan which is well underway and will be completed by March 29, 2013.
