



NOTICE OF ELECTIONS NBAPC President & Chief and Vice-Chief

Notice is hereby given to the Members of the New Brunswick Aboriginal Peoples Council, as well as any off-reserve Aboriginal person who qualifies for full membership, that an election will be held for the positions of **President & Chief and for Vice-Chief** of the Council, as per section 4.D. of the Constitution and By-Laws. The election will be conducted by Mail-in-Ballot **starting on June 6, 2019 and ending on July 20, 2019 at 12 noon.**

This election will be to elect a new President & Chief and Vice-Chief for a two year term.

Notice of Intent and Nomination

Anyone wishing to run for the positions of **President & Chief or Vice-Chief** must file a *Notice of Intent and Nomination* with the Chief Electoral Officer no later than **May 22, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.** on the prescribed form, along with an abstract of their current criminal record, as per section 3.E of the Constitution and By-Laws. Any person running for an Executive position must provide the Chief Electoral Officer with a current (dated within 60 days before nomination deadline) an abstract of their criminal record from the policing authority responsible for their place of residency along with nomination papers. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Voter's List

All full members (including non-resident members and lifetime members) will have their name automatically placed on the Voter's list.

Any off-reserve Aboriginal person who qualifies for Full Membership may apply to have their name added to the Voter's List on the prescribed form no later than **June 21, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.** Proof of address and ancestry must be provided to the Chief Electoral Officer.
